## The Presidents Trophy - 'Images Taken at The Quenington Fresh Air Exhibition'

Just a reminder that our President's choice of subject for the Pitchers Trophy (as above) relates to images taken at the Fresh Air Sculpture show which runs from 5th June - 26th June. As the website (link below) states:

Fresh Air Sculpture is a biennial sculpture exhibition held in the expansive organic garden of The Old Rectory in the Cotswold village of Quenington and affords a unique opportunity to see a creative mixture of traditional, modern and cutting-edge sculpture in a stunning outdoor setting. The Old Rectory gardens offer vast lawns joined by a bridge over the River Coln, hidden walkways through trees, pergolas and around tennis courts, beautiful flower and vegetable plots, and large impressive green houses. Fresh Air Sculpture gathers over 130 contemporary pieces of outside sculpture together in this tranquil setting, many of which have been created specifically for the gardens. The excitement of Fresh Air Sculpture is the huge diversity of materials exploring a variety of media: from stone to textiles, ceramic to glass, sound to video, mosaic to metals, rubber to resin. Monumental pieces sit alongside smaller works to suit every size of garden or outdoor space.

## Ever got caught short?

Of course I'm referring to that vital moment where you see a potential killer image which might work for one of the annual competition set subjects but you can't remember which comp, what the submission date is and what the set subject is! Dooh! We have the solution. In fact we might have a few solutions but here's the first which our tech wizard John S has been working on - based on using an iPhone

iPhone shortcuts.

As a camera club member, I like to have an aid memoir for the competition subjects and submitting dates when I'm out and about and, to this end, I normally create a note in the 'Notes' app on my iPhone. This generally works well but I've found that the note can get lost in amongst the many other notes that I create.

So, I decided to see if I could create a shortcut icon from the main screen of my iPhone to directly display a list of the competition subjects/dates which I will share below:

First, find a document that you wish to display, It will need to be a word .doc or apple page .page format (PDF does not work).

- 1. This can be created from the comprehensive list of comps below which Jill has created. It's a pdf but can be converted into .doc doc in Google.
- 2. Store the document on your iPhone let's call the document 'doc.doc'
- 3. Open the 'shortcut' app on your iPhone.
- 4. Select the '+ ' to create a new shortcut.
- 5. Select 'Add Action'
- 6. Select 'apps'
- 7. Select 'Pages' app
- 8. Select 'Open Document'
- 9. Now click on the 'Pages Document' (light blue) and browse to the doc.doc
- 10. Now click on the round blue icon top right.
- 11. Select 'Add to Home Screen'
- 12. Give the new shortcut a new name 'comp 22-23'
- 13. Click 'add'.
- 14. A new shortcut will now be on one of your home screens.

Let us know how you get on. Here's a short video to give you a heads up.
